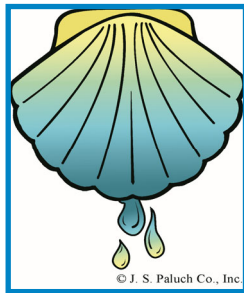

Some notes on the Diocese: Today our diocese is blessed with 120 diocesan priests along with 1026 religious men and women, serving 70 parishes, 252 mission stations. The total numbers of Catholics in the Diocese is approximately 250,000.

Our missionary programs include evangelization, faith formation, education, catechetical formation, etc. We need your support and generosity towards the formation of seminarians, the education of orphan children, the formation of women's self-help groups, development of the rural community, pastoral activities, the formation of small Christian communities and so much more. A special need is building Mission Chapels which are falling apart. With \$30,000, we are able to build one Chapel.
